

## Indonesia - Floods and landslides

After flash floods, landslides, and the Tondano River overflow that occurred in the Manado City area (North Sulawesi Province, northern-central Indonesia) on 27 January, the number of casualties has increased.

The ASEAN Disaster Information Network (ADINet) reports, as of 31 January, five fatalities, more than 1,900 displaced people, over 1,100 damaged houses (of which 453 totally damaged), two damaged bridges, and a total of nearly 16,700 affected people across the Manado City area.

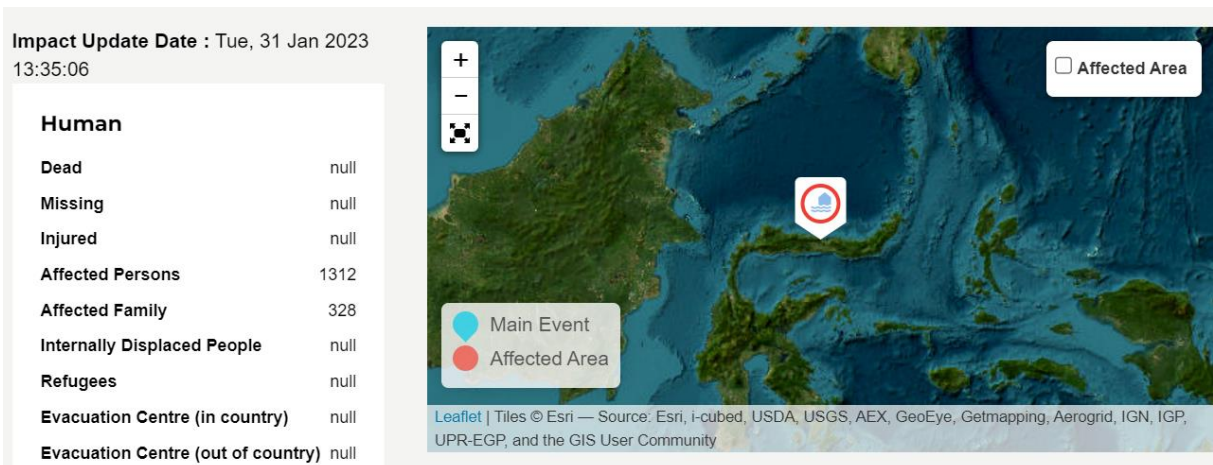
Over the next 24 hours, more heavy rainfall with locally very heavy rainfall is forecast over the whole of Sulawesi Island.

Indonesia, Flooding and Landslide in North Gorontalo (Gorontalo) (25 Jan 2023)

Chronological : Triggered by rain with moderate to high intensity in several areas of Gorontalo Province which resulted in flash floods and landslides as well as fallen trees so that access to Jl. Sulawesi between Kab. Buol and Kab. North Gorontalo completely cut off for 4 hours on Wednesday, January 25 2023 Pkl. 21:00 WITA

Location: Kec. Sumalata Timur: Ds. Deme I, Ds. Motihelumo, Ds. Dulukapa, Ds. Hulawa, Ds. Buluwatu, Ds. Kolowaka, Kec. Sumalata, Ds. Bulontio Timur, Ds. Bulontio Barat
